Teaching Fellowship in Philosophy. One-year residential fellowship, renewable for a second year, intended for graduate students at the dissertation stage of their studies interested in working with the Center for the Study of Ethics in the Professions and philosophy faculty at the Illinois Institute of Technology. Classes begin on August 21, 2023, and the Fellow is expected to arrive on campus the week prior. Salary is \$38,000 per year plus benefits and relocation assistance. Additional summer teaching opportunities are possible. We are interested in candidates interested in the field of applied ethics, bioethics, research ethics, and ethics of emerging technologies and artificial intelligence.

Candidates will be asked to teach upper and lower-level humanities courses, assist in developing ethics modules for Illinois Tech courses and engage in collaborative research with Ethics Center faculty, staff, and fellows. Funding for travel to professional conferences is available on a case-by-case basis.

Candidates must have completed all the requirements for the Ph. D. except for the dissertation, which they should plan to defend during the tenure of this fellowship. Illinois Tech is an Equal
