- PhD or doctorate in Business Ethics or another closely related field.
- Ability to teach graduate and undergraduate courses in business ethics.
- Demonstrated ability and commitment to teaching excellence.
- A strong research agenda in normative and/or empirical business ethics research with potential to publish high-quality research in peer-reviewed journals.
- A commitment to engaging in service to the Ethics and Business Law Department, the Opus College of Business, and the University of St. Thomas.

In order to be considered for this opportunity, interested applicants must apply online at <https://www.stthomas.edu/jobs/>. There are multiple parts to the application process. Applicants will first be asked to create an applicant profile and upload their supplemental application materials:

1. Curriculum vitae or resume
2. A written statement of teaching philosophy and research interests. The teaching philosophy section should speak to how the applicant works to develop inclusive learning environments (uploaded to “Teaching Philosophy and Research Interests” Field).
3. A sample of scholarly writing.

Please do not upload any additional documents into the other available fields within the candidate profile at this time. Further application materials may be requested at a later date, but no additional materials beyond those requested above are asked of you at this time.

After creating and submitting an applicant profile, you will be taken to the job specific application. Here you will be asked to copy/paste a cover letter, detailing your interest in the opportunity.

To ensure full consideration for the position, all application materials should be received by September 30, 2022; however, the position will remain open until filled. The search committee will begin scheduling Zoom interviews mid-October 2022.
